

Dear Parents and Students,

With the first Spanish test fast approaching, I have created a game that is specific to what the students need to know to prepare. The game does not encompass every detail that the students are responsible for. However, it does include the majority of the information. On Edline, look at the links section on the Spanish Page. Click on the link that says Brainiac. This will take you to the library page where you can download the game to your computer. Please follow these steps:

1. First, right click where it says “Right click here and choose save target as to save the supporting file to the same folder on your computer”. This link contains the questions and answers to the game. If this is not saved, the game will not run.
2. When the box comes up, decide where you want to save the file (I suggest the desktop).
3. Click the “save” button.
4. Then click where it says “click here to save the game on your computer”.
5. When the box comes up, click save.
6. Look back on your desktop. There should be a grey icon that says Brainiac. Double click it to begin the game.
7. When the game comes up, simply click on different dollar amounts and the questions will appear. This game is meant to be played by several people. We will actually play it as a review in class. However, encourage your child to play it alone in order to practice (along with traditional studying as well.)
